On December 1st, 2019, ITQAN Vocational Team conducted an On the Job Training (OJT) follow-up visits to National Inspection Services Company (Fahss TUV Nord) a sponsoring company in Dammam and met with a total of nine (9) ITQAN graduates from the 5th Cohort and their mentors/ supervisors. Sponsor staff mentors and supervisors were given orientation on job task standards in addition to duties and responsibilities of concerned parties. Overall, the team left the site with confidence that both graduates and mentors are ready to implement the OJT.



JAPANESE NEW INSPECTION TECHNOLOGIES TWO-DAY WORKSHOP

On January 27th 28th. Vocational ITQAN 2020. team attended the Japanese New Inspection Technology Workshop conducted at Saudi Aramco Ju'aymah NGL Fractionation Plant. The objective of the workshop was to showcase the latest inspection technology device (Rack-UT) introduced to Saudi Aramco installations lately.



On the first day, team from Japan Corporation Center Petroleum (JCCP) presented the achievements of the past



three years with Saudi Aramco on areas of inspection new technology platform and the technical collaboration. On the second day, JCCP team focused on the latest technology of pipe thickness measurement by the Rack-UT, the method of inspecting corrosion on outer surface of piping at pipe contacting part without lifting support. The two days' workshop ended by hands-on demonstration of using the Rack-UT device on defective pipes and test results of the application.

ITQAN GRADUATION COHORT VIII (MARCH 2020)

On March 5th, 2020, a total of one hundred (100) trainees from twelve (12) different sponsors successfully completed the two-year Inspection diploma program at ITQAN. 
SMOKE AWARENESS CAMPAIGN AND ITD RISK REGISTER COMMUNICATION
