








ITQAN GRADUATION COHORT NO. 17 (FEBRUARY 2024)



On March 14th, 2024, the final test results were verified and a total of one hundred and thirty-six (136) trainees from eleven (11) different sponsoring companies have successfully passed all the required examinations and have completed the two-year Inspection diploma program at ITQAN. The list of sponsoring companies included among others were Applus Velosi, CAT Group, Cutech, Hyundai Engineering, Nesma, Samsung, Sinopec, and TUV Rheinland. This graduation brings the total number of graduates from the institute to two thousand one hundred ninety-one (2191). These new graduates will add value to the development of the local workforce in the Inspection industry.
