Heat Stress Prevention and Maintenance

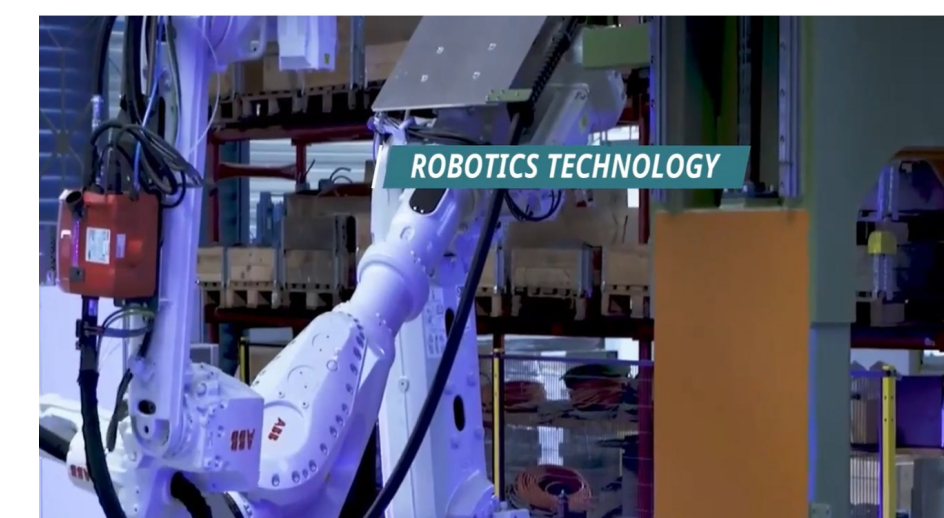
